- I. Elizabeth Blesses Mary because of Jesus - vv.39-45
1. Mary greets Elizabeth - vv.39-40
 2. Elizabeth blesses Mary because of Jesus - vv.41-45
 - A John leaps with Joy - v41, cf 1:15
 - B Elizabeth blesses Mary - v42
 - C Elizabeth acknowledges Mary's child as **Messiah** - v43
 - > Lord = Jesus is called Lord 20 times in Luke and is addressed as Lord 19 times; cf. Luke 2:11
 - > Mary is faithful and blessed by God but is not:
 - The Mother of God - God is self-existent, eternal
 - Perpetual virgin - cf. Matt. 1:25; Luke 8:19; Matt. 13:55-57; John 7:5
 - Virgin born nor free from personal sins - Rom. 3:10; 5:12; Luke 1:47
 - Not our mediator - 1 Tim 2:5-6
 - Not resurrected - 1 Cor. 15:20,23
 - A' John Leaps for joy - v.44, cf. 1:14-15
 - B' Elizabeth blesses Mary for her faith - v45
- II. Mary's song of praise to God - Luke 1:46-55, cf. 1 Sam 2
1. 1st stanza, vv.46-49 - Praise the Savior for His acts of grace
 2. 2nd stanza, vv.50-53 - Praise God for His acts of mercy
 - > Chiasmus = antithetical parallelism - a,b,b,a - vv.52-53
 - > Luke 16:19-31; Rev. 20:11-15
 3. 3rd stanza, vv.54-55 - Praise God for saving Israel
 - > Cf. Romans 11
