 - A. Christ was born without sin and identifies with sinners
Luke 2:21-24
 - > Christ's Circumcision identifies him with Israel and the Law - Cf. Gal 5:3; 4:4; Matt 5:17-18; Gal 3:13-14
 - > Christ's Presentation reveal his parents' loyalty to the Law

4. Hopeful living produces a peaceful life - Luke 2:29
 - > Cf. Phil. 4:7; Rom. 8:28-30
